

Isaiah's Homes of Love



Isaiah's Homes of Love was established to assist abandoned babies, orphans and children in desperate need of care. Since 2007 we have lovingly cared for over 100 babies and children. Where possible we seek to reunite these babies with extended family members. But many are also fostered, to be adopted, by loving families, whilst others are placed into 'forever family homes' and just a few are loved until they leave to be with the Lord.

This home for abandoned babies, currently cares for 26 children aged between newborn and five years old.

\$10 Babies formula

Buying a 900g tin of baby formula, the basis of a babies' diet, will feed a young baby for 5 days.



Three day's supply of fruit and vegetables to help them grow strong and healthy.

\$20 Drinks & snacks

A simple gift of the drinks a child needs weekly and the extra nutrition that gives them energy.

\$100 Staples & cleaning

One week's supply of porridge, meallie-meal (staple food) and all cleaning products required.





\$250 Baby carer

By paying the monthly wage of a baby carer relieves the pressure on Our Neighbours to pay for this quality, continuous care.



\$500 Matron & medicines

Half the monthly wage for Matron of the home, and all medicines and first-aid supplies required for one month.

This generous donation will pay monthly wages for three baby carers, and all of the bread, fresh fruit and vegetables required for one month.



Lighthouse Christian Academy

This is a school for children who have missed out on many years of schooling for various reasons, including those who have lived on the streets. We provide quality education as well as training in life skills, social development and health education.



\$10 Project research

Support two students for a term. Help students to go deeper into their education.

\$50 Extracurricular

Send the kids swimming for a month. These extra activities stimulate learning and self-esteem.

\$20 Porridge

Feed 15 students for a month. Help these children get a good start to their day.

\$100 School uniforms

Supply a child with uniforms for one year. Uniforms help build a sense of belonging for these lost children.



Purchasing various levels of Mini Text Books used throughout the year will provide the resourses needed by these students.

Northend Home

Northend Home began by providing some children with crisis accommodation and moved to assisting a group of children 15 years and under. Now Northend Home ensures that children are cared for in a family environment, where counselling, rehabilitation, and assistance with family or community reunification is available.



\$10 Fresh milk

Supplying milk for a week will increase the nutrition for these children.

\$50 Cleaning supplies

Keeping these children healthy means keeping the Northend Home clean too.

\$20 Fruit & vegetables

We all know that growing bodies need fruit and vegetables to help reach their potential.

\$100 Groceries

It costs a lot to feed growing children. Help keep their larders stocked.



All children benefit from some time away. This gift will send five boys on an active and fun-filled camp.



Hearts of Love

We desire to show Christ's love to people in need, loving individuals and families who are living in terribly difficult and disadvantaged circumstances. There are seven key ways we assist people: soup kitchen and food assistance; empowerment projects; health information service; individual and family assistance; community outreach; HIV support groups; and discipleship.



\$10 Medication

Such a small amount will provide blood pressure medication for one patient for a month.

\$50 Widows & orphans

Providing one month's food support for two widows caring for orphaned grandchildren.

\$20 Outreach

This gift will pay for hall rental for a weekly community outreach program in Trenance.

People and families in need rely on the soup kitchen for a nourishing meal in a caring environment.
